
Notice on Re-entry Permit

□ Application for Re-entry Permit

- **Applicable Persons:** All registered foreign residents, regardless of nationality, seeking re-entry into the ROK after departure on or after June 1, 2020.
- ※ Persons falling under the items ㉠, ㉡, or ㉢ are not required to apply for a re-entry permit. (Re-entry Permit Exempted)
 - ㉠ Diplomat (A-1), Government Official (A-2), International Agreement (A-3), or Overseas Korean (F-4) status holders
 - ㉡ Long-term stay foreigners who departed from the ROK prior to May 31, 2020 (Only applicable to those entering the ROK within the Re-entry Permit Exemption Period)
 - ㉢ Those recognized as refugees and holding a valid refugee travel document
- **How to Apply:** Re-entry Permit applications are available through the HiKorea website (www.hikorea.go.kr) or by visiting the immigration office of jurisdiction
- **Required Documents**
 - **Fully vaccinated against COVID-19:** Passport, Foreign Resident Registration Card, Notes for Re-entry and Consent Form for Confirmation, Certificate of Vaccination. No fees charged.
 - **Not fully vaccinated against COVID-19:** Passport, Foreign Resident Registration Card, Notes for Re-entry and Consent Form for Confirmation, Letter of Explanation regarding Re-entry Permit Application. Fee of 30,000KRW will be charged.
- **NOTE:** When departing from the ROK without receiving a Re-entry Permit shall result in cancellation of the Foreign Resident / Alien Registration (status and period of stay).

□ Obligation to be in possession of and to submit negative PCR test certificate (Re-entry will NOT be permitted without the test certificate)

- From January 8, 2021, all foreigners entering the ROK are required to submit a negative PCR test certificate issued within 72 hours before the date of departure. (However, children younger than 6 years old as of entry date will be allowed entry without submitting the negative PCR test certificate.)

□ Additional Notice

- Even if you were granted a Re-entry Permit as a COVID-19 vaccination certificate holder, you should check applicable quarantine measures as boarding may be restricted in accordance with each country's quarantine measures (such as mandatory additional vaccination after expiration of vaccination certificate).
